Having said that, it was again a challenging year for clubs with the introduction of PlayHQ. Many of us just want to play cricket, but forget that there is a lot of work to before and after a game to make sure the competition runs smoothly.

We all need to make sure we have appropriate transfers and permits in place, get our teams in PlayHQ early, use e-scoring as much as possible, get results in, and player statistics in accurately and timely. Managing a large competition is made easier if the background work is done in a timely manner.

We are proud that we are one of the few competitions in the north of Melbourne that offers 3 formats for senior cricket – two day matches, one day matches (Saturday and Sunday) and a T20 competition. We continue to attract clubs to our competitions as we offer varying formats.

We continue to see a shift away from the longer form of the game, and growth in the North and West of our regions.

We also continue to see some clubs closer to the CBD, and some smaller clubs struggling to maintain viability. We have seen a few of clubs merge over the last year or so, and the NWMCA will continue to support clubs to remain competitive and sustainable in any way we can.

We always look for continuous improvement in managing our competitions, including finding alternative sources of revenue, adjusting rules and by-laws as required, and recruiting dedicated and skilled administrators.

Thank you to all of the NWMCA Board, but especially our administrators – without them the competition wouldn't run as smoothly as it does. They do a superb job!

It was pleasing to start the junior season on time, given the delayed starts experienced since the 2018-19 season. I can report that the North West Metro Region experienced an overall decline in junior participation of 5.6% based on the decrease in the total number of boys/mixed teams from 270 in 2022-23 to 255 teams in 2023-24.

I would like to thank my fellow junior committee members Femi Ferzulla, Simon Fitzgerald, Steve Webb David Jessop, Srinivasa Koduru and Tim Branagan for all their assistance with rule reviews, gradings, permit requests, CMCU Junior Carnival and other issues to ensure junior games are played in the right spirit.

JUNIOR PATHWAY

Representative cricket is a key component of the development pathway of young cricketers. We partner and work with Cricket Victoria, Premier, Sub-District Clubs and the Victorian Metropolitan Cricket Union (VMCU) to provide junior players development and pathway opportunities.

Each year, the NWMCA enters boys and girls teams in the VMCU Junior Carnival. At the 2024 VMCU Carnival, we entered 7 boys representative teams in the various Shields and Cups. Each season we look to improve our North West representative program. This season we again ran nets trials indoors at the CitiPower Centre at the Junction Oval based on positive feedback received from all involved.

A special thanks to Steve Webb for coordinating the boy's representative selection trials, appointment of coaches and team managers and ensuring the carnival ran smoothly. Thanks to Bill for managing issues as needed. To all our junior players, parents, coaches and team managers thanks for proudly representing the NWMCA at the 2024 VMCU Carnival.

DIRECTOR OF UMPIRING REPORT 2023/2024

Changes to Laws of Cricket

There were no changes to the MCC's Laws of Cricket. The existing Laws (2017 Code 3rd Edition – 2022), will also remain current for next season – 2024/25.

Changes to NWMCA Rules

A significant revision to ONE DAY Match Rules retained the rule introduced during COVID to provide for a Cut-off time for the first side's innings if over rate was slow. In addition, the Cut-off times for all Open-Age Grades were standardised for simplicity for umpires/players swapping between grades.

Umpire availability

Covid created a decline in umpire participation across Victoria.

Cricket Victoria has initiated steps to address umpire availability.

Seniors: **Reduction in** NWMCA umpire numbers meant umpires were generally appointed to top five Grades only. After Christmas, several new umpires joined enabling two umpires to be appointed in nearly all Grand Finals matches.

Requests were received from lower Grade Clubs to provide an umpire to eliminate recurring misconduct in previous matches. However, responsibility for player conduct rests with Clubs and captains, and available umpires were appointed to higher Grades.

Juniors: No problem with attracting Junior Umpires prior to season starting. However, a significant drop-off rate occurs from Christmas. It was noticeable new umpires were less committed to umpiring each week than in previous seasons.

Women's Social T/20 Grades

Umpires were provided, when possible, to Women's Social T/20 Grades. Both senior and junior panel umpires were appointed to Women's matches.

Under Age Umpire Award - Terry Scott Medal

Elizabeth Mitchell, was awarded the Terry Scott Medal, awarded to the best Under Age Grades umpire for 2023/24.

Elizabeth was appointed to VMCU Carnival matches and was also selected to umpire matches in Cricket Victoria's Under 16 Dowling Shield and Under 15 Jennings Cup.

Cricket Victoria appointments:

In a new initiative to promote Junior umpiring, Cricket Victoria requested we supply Junior panel umpires for a number of matches in Under 16 Dowling Shield and Under 15 Jennings Cup matches.

Elizabeth Mitchell, Mathieson King and Joshua Whitfield were selected from the NWMCA panel.

Cricket Victoria advised all reports from Premier Clubs and umpire colleagues were exceptional for each game our three Juniors umpired. A great result for NWMCA.

VMCU Carnival Matches

Selected Junior and Senior umpires are invited to officiate in VMCU matches.

Juniors: Umpires who umpired most regularly: Marcus Lee (8 games including S/F & G/F), Joshua Whitfield (4), Evan Bell (3), and Ethan Brne (3).

Seniors: David Peers (5), Paul Simon (4) and Allan Taylor (3).

Eric Kelly

Eric Kelly assisted with the administration of our umpire panels, especially appointments to Open Age Grades. We utilised Eric's umpiring experience to demonstrate umpiring skills and the application of Laws & NWMCA Rules.

Eric plays a major pre-season role in initiating all new junior umpires to basic umpiring skills and on-field techniques.

CA Umpire Management computer system

Cricket Australia enforced on all Associations the PLAYHQ system replacing MyCricket. The umpire management system OFFICIALSHQ was added to PLAYHQ.

OFFICIALSHQ failed to provide any improvement on MyCricket to assist managing umpires. The new system was unfriendly to use, deficient with the appointments process, no email provision, lack of management and error reports, no ability to evaluate captains & umpire reports, etc.

The time requirement for OFFICIALSHQ to manage a large umpire panel was unacceptable. Surprisingly, the cricket authorities advised errors and omissions with OFFICIALSHQ would not be addressed until season 2024/25.

TREASURER'S REPORT

It is with much pleasure that I submit the Financial Report for Season 2023-2024, inclusive of the Independent Auditor's Report for the year ended 30 June 2023.

At the time of publishing, the Independent Auditor is scheduled to undertake the financial audit for the year ended 30 June 2024 on 18 July 2024, with his report expected shortly thereafter. That report will be made available to all clubs upon receipt and will be published with the Annual Report for Season 2024-2025.

I extend my sincere thanks to all club officials for their continued support and collaboration throughout the season to ensure the effective financial performance of your Association.

I am pleased to advise your Association achieved a Net Surplus of \$14,270.55 versus a planned Net Surplus of \$4,000.00. This result was due to slightly lower than budgeted administration costs and penalties imposed on clubs, the latter being income your Association does not plan for nor seeks to rely upon.

The non-merchandising cost base of your Association continues to experience price increases consistent with the broader economy, whilst significant planning has continued to lessen as much as possible the impact of continued price increases associated with future merchandising requirements. Consequently, inventories as at 30 June 2024 are representative of this planning and are intended to continue to provide some basis of fiscal support to all clubs in the coming financial year.

Importantly, your Association continues to maintain an appropriate level of liquidity as reflected by the working capital elements as detailed on the Statement of Financial Position.

Finally, you will note that your Association continues to be in a sound financial position, and, your Board continues to work tirelessly at providing fiscal prudence across all of its activities, as well as identifying value-add services for clubs in the future. To this final point, I extend my sincere thanks to your Association's administrators for their focus, attention to detail, commitment to all stakeholders, diligence and wise counsel.
