ADMINISTRATION MANAGER'S REPORT 2017/2018

Another season has successfully finished. I would like to thank president Steve Knight and the hard working board members for their efforts and support during the season.

Darrell Holt and Eric Kelly again excelled in providing both junior and seniors with the best umpires. Sonja along with Jill Boundy has proved to be excellent in organising the girls cricket Thanks to the super effort of these two we have the fastest growing girls comp in Vic. They are now helping cricket Victoria and other associations with hints on how to promote female cricket

Thank you Bill Maddern, you have proved to be one of the best appointments this association has ever made. Your tireless work on fixtures, Mycricket and communication to the member clubs has been extraordinary.

Last season we reintroduced a junior girl's competition to our association. This coming season under the skilled guidance of Sonja and Jill Boundy we will expand this competition and will expand into senior female cricket. I hope all clubs get behind us and support this initiative.

Cricket Victoria has now formed a regional committee to further the concept of a new regional cricket structure. Bob is part of this committee as a rep for NWMCA, Bernard Morrow is also on the committee as a club rep and also as a member of the VMCU. The new regional model has some very promising concepts but is still in the formative stage.

The Luscombe shield still continues to be a concern with regard to having 8 competitive clubs. At the moment we are having positive discussions with neighbouring clubs and associations to try and overcome this situation.

Cricket Australia, is still pushing very hard to have the all competitions adopt the new formats, We still have the problem of our under 10 program, which is in its 28th year, not being accepted as a legitimate competition by Cricket Australia. However, we didseek to trial some levels in the new format but Cricket Australia wanted an all or nothing approach. I am hoping we will be able to find ways to introduce the formats in a way that is accepted by our clubs and meets the approval of Cricket Australia. The game of cricket is changing and the board and administrative staff will have plenty of work ahead.

Finally, a big thank you to all clubs for their ongoing support of the NWMCA.

DIRECTOR OF UMPIRING REPORT 2017/2018

NEW MCC LAWS OF CRICKET (2017)

Paramount focus for the season was the education of umpires and players on the new MCC Laws of Cricket, implemented from 1st October 2017.

NWMCA fully adopted the new Laws, with only minor variations for Under Age Grades. The new Laws have significant amendments and complexities with re-wording, and re-numbering alterations to each of the 42 Laws.

Major changes to affect all cricket matches included:

tightening of Unfair Play Laws with increased instances for 5 Run Penalties

bowler suspension procedures strengthened for dangerous and unfair deliveries

amendments for dismissals when ball strikes helmet

restrictions on fielding substitutes

a new Law 42 defining Players' misconduct

NWMCA conducted several pre-season information sessions on the new Laws for Senior Clubs'delegates, Junior Clubs' coaches/managers, and extensive training of umpires.

LAW 42 PLAYERS' MISCONDUCT

MCC introduced Law 42 to deter objectionable misconduct particularly in relation to dissent and verbal abuse of opposition players.

The new Law 42 introduced definitions for four levels of misconduct.

Level 1 and Level 2 infringements require umpires to report offending player(s). Level 3 and Level 4 require offenders to additionally be removed from the game.

NWMCA Board made consequential changes to NWMCA Reporting Procedures rules to correspond to the new Law 42:

deletion of Cautions for minor misconduct

two-weeks Set Sentence for player accepting Level 1 offence

four-weeks Set Sentence for player accepting Level 2 offence

deletion of reprimands and suspended sentences by Tribunal.

As a result of the new Law 42, NWMCA Open-Age Grades had 25 players placed on misconduct reports during the 2017/18 season- a matter for some concern?

Season 2017/18 retained a senior umpiring panel of 45 umpires.

The average assessment by captains of the overall umpiring performance was maintained at a high level commensurate with 2016/17 season.

Umpire unavailability was again high - especially during the finals series. Despite high unavailability, two umpires were appointed to all Luscombe Shield matches and two umpires were appointed to Grand Finals in all Grades.

Calvin Francis joined Cricket Victoria's 2017/18 umpire panel.

Cricket Victoria requested NWMCA to supply umpires to matches for 3 days of Victorian State Championships (Girls) and also for the Victorian Renegades T/20 series. It is encouraging that CV recognises our umpiring standards by requesting NWMCA umpires - we are the only metropolitan cricket association asked to assist CV.

Umpire training on Laws/Rules and techniques is conducted at the Association's monthly meetings. Match appointments favour umpires attending meetings.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK (WWC)

All NWMCA Senior umpires hold the Department of Justice's WWC clearance. Allan Taylor again administered this program to ensure compliance by all adult umpires.

ACB ACCREDITATION

All NWMCA umpires (seniors and juiors) must qualify for at least the ACB Level 1 Umpiring Accreditation. We have CV permission to conduct ourselves the Level 1 practical course at NWMCA Office.

VMCU CARNIVAL MATCHES

VMCU representative matches were umpired by Gordon Andrews, Brian Hedger, Tony Hosking, **Rick** Klepacki, Vince Malarbi, Steven Pastras, Allan Taylor, and Mark Winkle.

ERIC KELLY

Eric Kelly assisted with the administration of our umpire panels. Erlc presented training for senior umpires at monthly meetings, especially important for the new Laws of Cricket.

UNDER-AGE GRADES PANEL

Umpires seeking games appointments was unprecedented - we stopped accepting applications from new umpires in August when the panel exceeded 100 umpires. For each round, several umpires were rostered on "Standby".

UNDER AGE UMPIRE AWARD-TERRY SCOTT MEDAL

Daniel Spencer, was adjudged the best Under Age umpire for season 2017/18.


